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After a 3rd online edition due to the pandemic, **CinespañaLab** is physically back this year **on Monday 4 and Tuesday 5 October 2021** with a 4th edition entirely dedicated to animated feature films. Our work continues with the aim of strengthening cooperation between French and Spanish film professionals and promoting co-productions on both sides of the Pyrenees.

Four Spanish projects in development have been selected to be presented to French producers and professionals through One-to-One meetings, in order to receive feedback and develop partnerships. At the conclusion of these meetings, a professional jury will give the CinespañaLab Award, awarding a Spanish feature film project in development. As part of this award, Le Joli Mai laboratory will provide technical support worth €2,000. The selected Spanish projects will also benefit from a mentoring session with a programmer of the Annecy Festival, Yves Nougarède.

In addition to these events, French and Spanish audio-visual institutions will have a moment to present their work, their development aids and the animation film production. A case study of the feature films *Josep* (Aurel, 2019) and *They shot the piano player* (Fernando Trueba, in development) will also be presented by Les Films d'ici Méditerranée.

Cinespaña is pleased to continue supporting the development of quality film projects and promoting economic and cultural cooperation between our two countries.

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SYNOPSIS

A group of sub-Saharan migrants arrive on the coast of Cádiz. The police intercept them and direct them to a sports centre where they spend the night. Among them is Awa, a girl of just 13 years old, dressed as a boy. During the few hours that Awa has been in European territory, and while she tries to escape from the enclosure to contact her cousin who lives in Seville, Awa recalls the most important episodes of her journey.

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SYNOPSIS

A biochemist is kidnapped in the jungle by a Colombian paramilitary group to fabricate drugs. There, he creates a synthetic drug that allows him to defeat his kidnappers by using excessive violence. Transformed into a drug addict who answers by the name Disposable, he lives in the streets with his dog, his only companion. When the dog dies due to arson, the pain and desire of revenge transform him into The Hummingbird, a murderer that fights against corruption and social repression.

Carlos Gómez Salamanca's work focuses on painting and audio-visual languages. In his recent works he reconstructs images and visual archives in order to create animations that explore, from a critical perspective, different social and cultural aspects of his country.

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SYNOPSIS

Inspired by the music and life of Robert Wyatt, *Rock Bottom* is a self-destructive love story between Bob and Alif, a young couple of artists immersed in the creative whirlwind of the early 70s hippie culture. Drugs will turn a passionate summer into a nightmare in a journey through the themes of Wyatt music: the euphoria and anguish of artistic creation, the unconscious fascination with drugs, the disenchantment with routine and physical and mental degradation.

DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Maria Trénor is an animation short film director and producer. Her films have premiered at the Sundance and Annecy Festivals, and have won national and international awards, such as 1st Teddy Bear for Best Short film at Berlinale and Best Short Film at ANIMADRID. Her works have been nominated for the Goya Awards.

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SYNOPSIS

From the beginning of the Spanish Civil War, Madrid is besieged, and the bombardments soon become a distressing and deadly routine for the people. And a danger to the artistic heritage. Incendiary shells hit the Prado Museum. They fail to burn, but a decision was taken. The Republic commissioned the young and impetuous Josep Renau, a poster artist and activist, and Timoteo Pérez, a shy painter, to organise the transfer of the works to keep them away from destruction, following the government under attack. In November 1936 begins a dizzying three-year journey through a broken country.

Paco Sales is dedicated to different artistic disciplines related to drawing, writing, animation and teaching. He has published books in Spain and France. He is an educator in Museums where he designs and teaches Didactic Workshops. He also teaches classes at University.
